Summer Reading 2011 Puzzle/Activity Instructions

Each week for 6 weeks there will be a set of activity sheets for summer reading participants. One will be easier (up to 3rd grade) and one will be harder (4th grade—6th grade.) Third graders can do the harder one if they want to try. There is also a coloring sheet for those too young to do the easier puzzles. The coloring sheet will be put with the easier puzzles and a name will be chosen from all of those completed. However, only one set of puzzles per person will be put in the drawing for a prize. The themes of the puzzles will be the different continents.

One winner from each age group (preschool—3 and 4—6) will be randomly chosen from all COMPLETED and CORRECT entries. The winner will receive an assortment of prizes from among those on display in the Children's room display case.
